INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE  
FOR THE DRMS HAZARDOUS PROPERTY PROGRAM<sup>1</sup>

A. REFERENCES.

B. PURPOSE. This instruction assigns responsibility, provides procedures and implementing guidance for executing the environmental management and compliance requirements of the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Service (DRMS) Environmental Compliance for the Hazardous Property Program. (For the purposes of this directive, the “DRMS Environmental Compliance for the Hazardous Property Program” will be referred to as “the DRMS Environmental Program” or, as “the environmental program”.)

C. APPLICABILITY AND SCOPE. This instruction is applicable to DRMS and all DRMOs.

D. DEFINITIONS. Chapters I through XXXII contain unique terms and definitions applicable to the regulatory requirements discussed in specific chapters of the instruction.

E. RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. The Hazardous Division (DRMS-LH), under the Marketplace (DRMS-L), shall exercise primary staff responsibility for managing and administering the DRMS Environmental Program world-wide.
2. The Field Operations Support Office under the National Commander shall exercise operational control and oversight.

3. The Environmental Branch, under the Chief of the DRMO shall execute the day-to-day hazardous property and environmental management operations of the DRMO(s).

F. PROCEDURES.

1. The Hazardous Division (DRMS-LH) shall perform the mission and functions as assigned in reference A2, Part III, Chapter 1, Section 1200.

2. The Field Operations Support Office shall perform the mission and functions as assigned in reference A2, Part II, Chapter 2, Sections 2300, 2320, and 2400.

3. The Environmental Division of DRMSI, shall perform the mission and functions as assigned in reference A2, Part II, Chapter 2, Sections 3300 and 3310.

4. The Environmental Branch, under the DRMO Chief shall:

a. Perform the mission and functions as assigned in reference A2, Part V, Section 1116.

b. Assist the DRMO Distribution Branch in the performance of the reutilization, transfer, donation, and sale of hazardous property. The Distribution Branch shall perform the functions as assigned in reference A2, Section 1115 as applicable to hazardous property.

G. INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS. Requests for revisions, changes, exceptions or waivers to this instruction may be submitted in writing to the Commander, Defense Reutilization and Marketing Service, ATTN: DRMS-LHP, 74 N. Washington Ave., Battle Creek, MI 49017-3092. Proposed revisions or changes to this instruction shall be staffed for comments, with Headquarters DRMS, DRMS National Commander, and DRMS International Commanders, prior to final publication of changes to the instruction.

H. EFFECTIVE DATE AND IMPLEMENTATION. The attached instruction is effective and shall be implemented upon distribution.
